Masks/Face Coverings for Students

- ✓ Students in grades **K-12** when physically present on campus, face coverings will be required at certain times throughout the day (on buses, during transitions, when directed in classes, and when social distancing is not possible). A washable mask will be provided for students to wear in grades **K-12**.
- ✓ Students who are in a high-risk group (previous health concerns, immune deficiency, etc.) will be highly encouraged to wear a face mask at all times.
- ✓ An ill student will be removed from the classroom and moved to a designated area for isolation.
- ✓ District staff will instruct students in the proper manner in which a mask should be worn.
